Last April 13th, the first Dolphin Day Forum was carried out, as well as a series of conferences took place with the presence of Veterinarians and Marine Mammals Specialist from Dolphin Discovery, the University of Quintana Roo, the National Science and Technology Council (CONACYT for its acronym in Spanish), and the Office of the Federal Attorney General (PGR for its acronym in Spanish). They exposed different topics about the importance of Dolphins and to create awareness in people about the care of this species and their habitat.

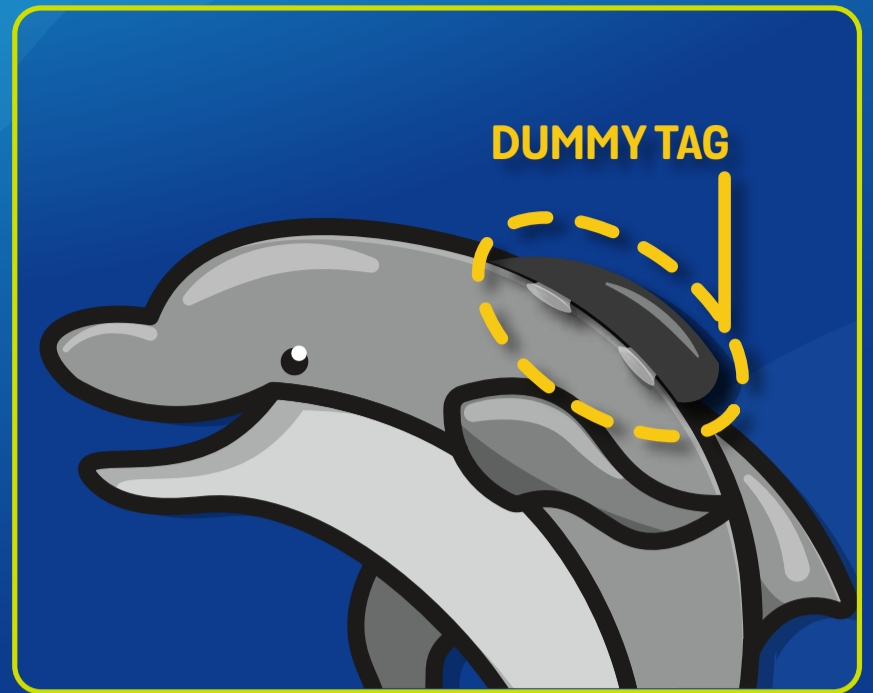

DOLPHIN DISCOVERY PARTICIPATES IN AN IMPORTANT PROJECT FOR THE WELFARE OF CETACEANS

Different national and international institutions such as Dolphin Discovery, that look after the welfare of cetaceans, have joined the research led by the Chicago Zoological Society & Brookfield Zoo, a non-profit organization with the purpose of inspiring conservation through the connection of people with wildlife and nature.



THIS RESEARCH WILL PROVIDE SIGNIFICANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE WELFARE OF CETACEANS UNDER HUMAN CARE.

Specifically, this research will identify how the characteristics of the physical environment, and the enrichment programs, influence the Dolphins' welfare. This will be measured by behavior, activity, movement and physical health.

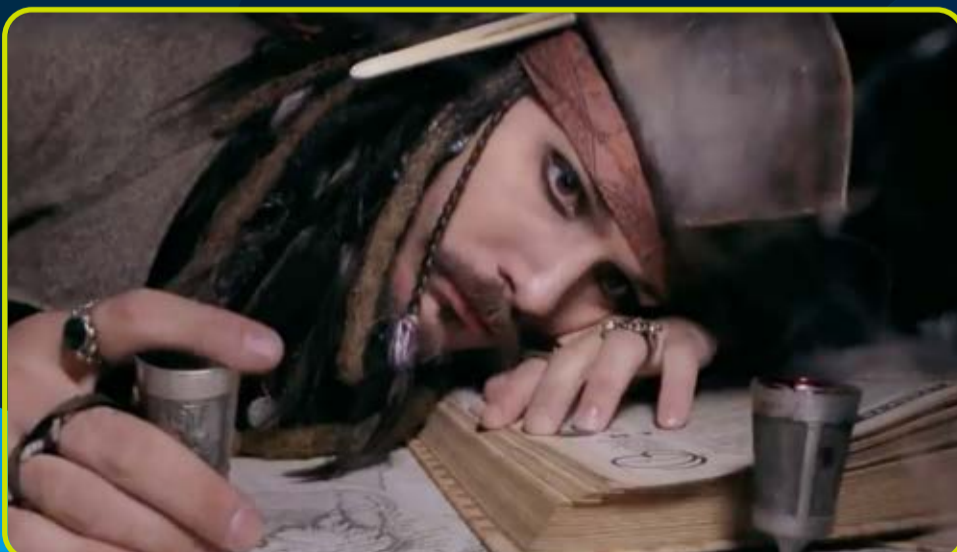
The data recording device named "dummy tag", places on the dorsum in some of our species, between the dorsal fin and the blowhole, is a non-invasive device which adheres to the skin through suction cups.
