ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS TOUR





In the last trimester of 2019, we carried out a tour in schools and foundations in the state of Quintana Roo, Mexico, with the objective of increasing awareness about environmental care in children and teenagers. In kindergartens and elementary schools, this job of education was carried out through a play inspired in the book "The Ocean Adventures of Tursi, Pinni and Mydas", in which one of the characters gets entangled in trash and it's through this story that we teach the damage that pollution causes to the oceans.

In middle and high schools, we conducted a rally in which the students learned facts about recycling, marine species and how we can help take care of the environment. During this tour, we visited 19 public and private schools, as well as foundations of children in vulnerable conditions. 1,024 kids and teenagers received environmental education thanks to this program.

The "Dolphin Race", a yearly race organized by Dolphin Discovery, will now take place in Cancun. It will be a race with a cause held on Sunday, March 22nd at 7:00 am in the Country Club facilities and with the special feature of being pet friendly. The limit of participants for this Dolphin Race, will be 700 runners, divided in the next categories:

COVE RESCUE OF DOLPHINS

This past December 29th, the Department of Veterinary Medicine in Dolphin Cove, Jamaica, received a call from the National Environmental Protection Agency (NEPA) to request help in the stranding of a Dolphin in the Port Maria beach.

Also on January 3rd a Stenella Genus Dolphin that presented scars of previous wounds was stranded in the same beach. Dolphin Cove's Rescue Team arrived to the site in order to perform the pertinent actions.

The Rescue Team helped the Dolphins, and conducted medical exams to identify the cause of stranding. Since minor infections were detected on both Dolphins required medication was provided. After a few hours they were transported by boat for their reintegration to the sea.

Thanks to the knowledge we have on Marine Mammals, it is possible for us to help animals in wildlife.







TURTLE RESCUE IN ITALY



During the month of November, veterinarians of Zoomarine, in Italy, rescued 5 turtles of the Caretta caretta species, also commonly called the loggerhead sea turtle.

The first one, called Marianna, presented a kidney infection, so it remained in observation until its recovery and was released back into the sea on December 7th in front of Zoomarine's coast.

Nerone, and Marinella, had many wounds on their flippers due to fishing nets, Marinella also required surgery since it had a long fishing line that ran through the intestine; both turtles recovered in the Specialized Rescue Center of Naples.

Lastly, Camilla and Nica were rescued. The first one presented a constriction on the right fore flipper due to a fishing net, while Nica, due to her small weight (20g), was unable to face up to the storm surges.
